This is an Independence Day parade and we realize that a huge variety of entries participate in this parade. We encourage all entrants to create a float or an entry that clearly portrays this year's theme.

JUDGING: Judging categories for this year will be:

“JUDGE’S CHOICE” - \$700

“BEST USE OF THEME” - \$500

“BEST DISPLAY OF PATRIOTISM” - \$500

All entries should be **completed and ready for judging by 8:00 a.m. on July 3, 2021.** Judging will be conducted along the parade route as the floats pass the judges station. The judges station is located in front of the Chamber of Commerce. Winners will be announced just before dusk at the FreedomFest event at Show Low High School. So come on over to see the announcements and enjoy the spectacle of fireworks!

IMPORTANT RULES & REGULATIONS TO READ PRIOR TO BUILDING YOUR FLOAT

1. All entries will be subject to approval by the 4th of July parade committee. Any entry that does not conform to these rules and regulations will be **ELIMINATED** from consideration. All decisions of the Parade Committee are final. Entry fees submitted for an entry that is not approved will be refunded.
2. **ABSOLUTELY NO CANDY IS TO BE THROWN FROM A FLOAT.** For the safety of everyone, candy or other items may be distributed by parade walkers only at **CURBSIDE** along the parade route. Any participants throwing candy from their float will be **DISQUALIFIED** from judging and **PROHIBITED** from participating in future parades. *Throwing items from your parade entry will encourage children to run into the streets.*
3. Canned party spray, silly string, poppers, or other pressurized items are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** and are not to be used near the parade or staging area.
4. Any entry not complying with the rules and regulations as set forth by the Parade Committee will **NOT** be allowed to participate in the parade (or in future parades).
5. Please keep in mind that this is a “FAMILY” parade and all entries should be “G-RATED.”
6. **PARADE PACKET PICK UP** is available on June 28 & 29 at Show Low Family Aquatic Center 1100 W. Deuce of Clubs, Show Low.
7. We do not limit your float entry by length however, you are asked to provide the information on the application. The **MAXIMUM HEIGHT** clearance for all float entries is 14 feet. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
8. Advertising and identification of floats and themes should be kept to a minimum and be in good taste. All entries are **REQUIRED TO DECORATE** their floats. *Entries are discouraged to just stick signs on a vehicle.* Be **MEMORABLE!**
9. All float entries with electronic equipment (i.e., speakers, amplifiers) should carry a fire extinguisher on or in the vehicle or float.
10. All unlicensed vehicles must be approved by and have the consent of the City of Show Low Parks and Recreation Department.

PARADE RULES & INSTRUCTIONS

The following safety rules have been implemented for the Show Low FreedomFest Parade Please read all rules carefully they are strictly enforced and must be followed at all times.

STAGING:

1. Your staging area will be designated by a large sticker on the front of your parade packet.

2. **ALL FLOAT ENTRIES STAGED AT SHOW LOW CITY PARK MUST enter the Show Low City Park from the Highway 260 entrance.** Please do not attempt to enter from Deuce of Clubs or the Aquatic Center, vehicles will be turned around at these locations.
3. The inside of the park will be closed and open to floats only.
4. **ONLY** float entries will be allowed to park at the Show Low City park, personal vehicles or vehicles for parade participants can be parked in the stake center parking lot across the street.
5. **ALL FLOAT ENTRIES STAGED AT NPC MUST enter NPC from the west Deuce of Clubs entrance. The roundabout entrance will be barricaded.** Equestrian & large float entries will be staged in the Northland Pioneer College parking lot.
6. Entries should arrive at your *assigned staging area* by **7:00 a.m.** **PARADE NUMBERS & WAIVERS** will be located in your parade packet. We ask you be early to ensure everyone is in the correct parade lineup. **WAIVERS MUST BE SIGNED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AND BE READY FOR PICK UP BY CITY STAFF AT 7:15 A.M.** Waivers are **MANDATORY** for participation in the parade.
7. **PARADE PARTICIPANT DROP OFF** - Parade participants can be dropped off at two locations: the stake center parking lot and they walk across to the park entrance; or on W. Owens St. at the first entrance near the little league field.

FLOATS:

1. **ABSOLUTELY NO CANDY IS TO BE THROWN FROM A FLOAT, VEHICLES, OR HORSES.**
For the safety of everyone, candy or other items may be distributed by parade walkers only at CURBSIDE along the parade route. Any participants throwing candy from their float will be DISQUALIFIED from judging and PROHIBITED from participating in future parades. *Throwing items from your parade entry will encourage children to run into the streets.*
2. Canned party spray, silly string, poppers, or other pressurized items are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** and are not to be used near the parade or staging area.
3. Please keep in mind that this is a "FAMILY" parade and all entries should be "G-RATED."
4. Children under the age of six (6) years must be accompanied by an adult.
5. Children under the age of twelve (12) must be "**SEATED**" on any and all types of floats/vehicles.
6. Children ages twelve (12) and older and "standing" on a float/vehicle must have something stable to hold on to for balance.
7. **DO NOT SLOW** the parade flow! The parade **PACE** is 90 steps per minute and will be enforced by parade officials. Due to the number of entries and time allowance, there cannot be delays or stops to perform. Entries should proceed in a straight line, NO WEAVING. There should be 2 car lengths between floats & banners.
8. All UNLICENSED vehicles must be PRE-APPROVED by and have the consent of the City of Show Low Parks and Recreation Department.

EQUESTRIAN:

1. For safety reasons only one (1) rider per horse, unless you are accompanying a child under 10.
2. Children under the age of ten (10) will not be allowed to ride on a horse alone during the parade. Child must be accompanied by an adult, walking, or riding.
3. All children riding on a horse **MUST** wear a protective helmet.
4. Any vehicle being pulled by a horse(s) (includes, but is not limited to a wagon, stage coach, or trailer) must have an adult walking alongside or riding with the horse(s) to help control the horse(s) throughout the parade route. A safety rope/out-rigging must be attached to the team lead to stop the team.

OHV, UTV, & ATV'S:

1. State law requires that operators and passengers of OHV's under the age of 18 must wear a helmet. All parade participants under the age of 18 on ATV's or UTV's **MUST** wear a DOT approved helmet.

GROUP ENTRANTS:

1. Unfortunately, we do not have space for entrants to show all of their vehicles. PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT **NO MORE THAN 20 VEHICLES PER ENTRANT** IS ALLOWED.
2. If your entry is a group, please be certain that all members of the group know their position number and all the necessary details prior to parade day.

WET ZONE:

1. **THERE IS NO WET ZONE DURING THE PARADE** – Following the parade, the City of Show Low sponsors a free “WET & WILD ZONE” event that is held at Frontier Park, 660 N. 9th Place Show Low.
2. No WATER BALLOONS or other thrown objects are allowed during the parade.

JUDGING:

1. All entries should be **completed and ready for judging by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 3, 2021.** Judging will be conducted along the parade route as the floats pass the judges station. Winners will be announced just before dusk (approximately 6:45 pm) at the FreedomFest event at Show Low High School. So come on over to see the announcements and enjoy the spectacle of fireworks!
2. There will be no discrimination on basis of race, color, national origin, religion, gender, age or disability.
